DRESS CODE REQUIREMENTS

Students who are wearing non-school coloured shirts **WILL BE ASKED TO CHANGE.**
Denim clothing and hoods are not permitted to be worn under any circumstances.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

- Students must change into jade polo shirts and black shorts for Physical Education classes
- School Tracksuits may be worn in winter

FOOTWEAR

- Appropriate footwear must be worn. No slip-on sandals, thongs or ugg boots, etc. (NB It is a safety requirement that students attending Design and Technology, Home Economics or Science classes wear covered footwear.)

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Excessive make-up or jewellery is not appropriate
- Hats and sunscreen should be worn outdoors
- Winter coats, parkas, etc should be removed when students enter classrooms
- Hats are not to be worn indoors
- Students representing the school or participating in school excursions are expected (unless notified to the contrary) to dress within the above guidelines
