

Good Standing Policy

The Lakeland Good Standing Policy has been put in place to provide clear expectations of how students at Lakeland Senior High School should conduct themselves. All students commence with, and retain good standing, while exhibiting behaviours that align with the school's values and beliefs as articulated in the school's behaviour plan. Students who do not meet the objectives of the schools policy will lose privileges such as being in attendance at school social activities. All students will have the opportunity to regain their good standing as outlined below.

Lost Good Standing due to attendance being below 90 (adjusted for Covid 19).

1. Student to complete a Good Standing Reinstatement Plan.
2. Parent to explain absences. Absences with that have a reasonable cause will not count towards a student's 90% attendance rate.
3. Student to complete attendance plan with Academic Coordinator.
4. Student to bring attendance back over 90% over a of 5 week period.

Lost Good Standing due to truanting (any instance recorded).

1. Student to complete a Good Standing Reinstatement Plan.
2. Student to complete attendance plan with Academic Coordinator.
3. Student to complete check sheets for designated periods.
4. Student to complete missed work at homework club or complete do detention for missed periods.

Lost Good Standing due to three reports of poor behaviour over the term.

1. Student to complete a Good Standing Reinstatement Plan.
2. Student to complete class behaviour monitoring sheet.
3. Student to demonstrate positive community behaviour by completing community service with teachers who reported behaviour or Academic Coordinator.

Lost Good Standing due to not wearing uniform more than three times.

1. Students to complete a Good Standing Reinstatement Plan.
2. Student to have completed detention for not wearing uniform.
3. Student to wear correct uniform for a period of four weeks.

Lost Good Standing due to suspension

1. Student to complete a re-entry meeting with the staff member who reported behaviour and LET representative. Student to meet conditions of Behaviour Management Plan.
 - a. These conditions may include using a Behaviour Monitoring Sheet, completing additional support meetings with LET member and written apologies.
 - b. Completion of community service relevant to student and misdemeanour.
2. Once conditions are met the student is to complete a Good Standing Reinstatement Plan.

Please note- students are responsible for regaining their Good Standing. Students need to actively work towards correcting their breach of policy. Good Standing will not be reinstated until the student has followed the correct process.
