## DRESS CODE REQUIREMENTS

<b>JACKET/ JUMPERS</b>	With Embroidered School Logo Plain Black Pullover/ Jacket Leavers Jackets/Jumpers	ANY <b>non-school</b> logo jumper <b>No HOODED</b> Jumpers/Jackets
<b>SHOES</b>	Enclosed Footwear	Thong style; including slides & crocs Backless/ Sandals High heels Ugg Boots
<b>HATS / BEANIES/SCARVES</b>		Not to be worn in classrooms / assemblies

Students who are wearing non-school coloured jackets will be asked to remove them. If it is an extremely cold day, students will be asked to 'swap' their non-school jacket for a school jacket and then return at the completion of the day. Students wearing non-school pants/shorts will be asked to collect a dress pass. Parents will be contacted. After three dress passes, students will be given detention at recess or lunch time for violating the school code of conduct.

Hats and sunscreen should be worn outdoors
